Marlborough School 2026 SDP, Budget and Fees Engagement Meeting – Summary of Feedback and Questions

Below you will find the questions and comments provided during the SDP, Budget and Fees Engagement meeting. This took place during the School Council and Parents' Society meeting on March 2, 2026. It was an online meeting with 7 participants.

We share SDP information and updates in different ways. In what ways have you learned about our SDP?

- School council meetings – in the fall when we discuss the data and goals and in the spring when we have this meeting

The SDP is developed with all students in mind. Do you agree that your child's learning can benefit from the goals, outcomes, actions and resources in the SDP? That the learning of all students is reflected and prioritized in the goal, action and resources in the SDP?

- How can our Council provide more resources for the teachers? What challenges are teachers facing implementing this plan?
- How do we know the actions are working? If it is too soon for report card data to be available, when will we have that information?

Schools must operate within their budget and too many fees can be unmanageable for families. Knowing that, what activities and services are most important to you?

- Field trips
- Fun experiences and events at school that kids will remember

Do you agree that: the activities our school provides (e.g., field trips, guest speakers, experts in schools, sporting activities, outdoor education, etc.) are important for your child's learning? The school fees you pay are reasonable considering the benefit they provide your child? (*note: no fees are charged at our school for these experiences because of the generous support of School Council/Parents' Society*)

- It's important to us to fund these experiences for students so no one misses out, and burdens are not placed on families
- We want to make sure there are lots of experiences for students to enjoy.
